Incorporated as a private, not-for-profit charitable agency, our programs rise to meet the needs of our aging community.

The Information and Referral Service is available to answer questions, and provide one-on-one personalized guidance and referral services available through SCOPE, Inc. or other agencies in the community.

We can refer individuals 60 and over to a variety of services to help seniors remain living independently in their homes as an alternative to nursing facilities.

Our Social Work Outreach Program provides a licensed social worker to visit the home to counsel those in need.

The Representative Payee Program provides financial management for seniors who are deemed incapable



of handling their financial affairs and all other traditional networks of support are not available.

The Food Bank is available every Thursday at the Warren SCOPE Senior Center for eligible participants. Contact Information & Referral for eligibility requirements.

AARP Free Income Tax Preparation is available each year through various SCOPE sites.

Roberta Graham from 1962-1992, and Janet E. Schweitzer from 1993 to present.


Membership is open to all senior citizens 50 years old and up for a contribution of only \$12 per year or \$22 for a couple.

All of SCOPE's In Home Services are available to anyone at least 50 years of age on a Private Pay basis. Discounts are offered to SCOPE members.

To be eligible for SCOPE'S subsidized In Home Services, the client must be at least 60 years of age and meet the Department of Human Service's age and income requirements. SCOPE is a certified PASSPORT provider.

Prescription Assistance Program

Provides access to prescription drugs offered by pharmaceutical companies through prescription assistance programs.

SCOPE does not issue the prescriptions itself. It is a portal that helps patients find those programs that do offer assistance.

In addition, assistance in Medicare Insurance decisions are offered year-round and especially at the Open Enrollment Period each year.

It is important to do a new comparison every year to determine if it is beneficial to change your plan.

Personal comparisons and reviews are done at the Warren SCOPE site by appointment Monday through Friday.
