November 2015 to October 2017 Billing Cycles

- Flat Rate - **\$3.67/Mcf**
- Provider: **Constellation Energy Services**
- *You must **Opt-in** to receive this rate* by one of the following methods:
 - **Mail** the form sent to you in the pre-addressed stamped envelope
 - **Fax** the form to 1-920-272-4244
 - **Call** Constellation at **1-877-225-9416**
 - **Online** at www.constellation.com/oh-cortland

November 2017 to October 2019 Billing Cycles

- Flat Rate - **\$3.32/Mcf**
- Provider: **Constellation Energy Services**
- More information will be provided regarding enrollment, but the rate has been locked in for two years.
- Customers currently in city program are supposed to automatically go into new rate program.

Gas is billed through Dominion.

What is Opt-in Aggregation?

- Customers must call to join and are not automatically included

- Fixed Price Options
- Price Buying Leverage
- Risk Mitigation & Cost Control
- Best Combination of Term, Service & Pricing Available

How Will I Be Billed?

- Meter Reads & Billing by Local Utility
- New Supplier Gas Charge Included on Bill
- Payments Made to Local Utility
- Budget Billing Option Availability Continues
- Automatic Payment Option Availability Continues
- Gas Service Line and Other Insurance Programs Unaffected
- Itemization of LDC's Regulated Charges
- Itemization of Supplier's Deregulated Charges

How Will My Account be Serviced?

- Via Local Distribution Company (LDC), Dominion East Ohio
- Meter Reads & Billing
- Maintenance of Pipeline Delivery System

Who is Eligible to Participate?

- Governmental, Residential Account Holders in Community
- Commercial Account Holders in Community using less than 2,000 Mcf/Year

Who is Not Eligible to Participate?

- PIPP Customers
- Delinquent Bill Payees
- Customers Under Contract with third Party Supplier; However They Can Opt-In by Calling Program Supplier
- Commercial Accounts in Community greater than 2,000 Mcf/Year, however they can Call Buckeye Energy Brokers For Pricing

What if I'm Moving into The Community?

- May Not Receive Program Offer Mailing
- Need to Contact Supplier
- Need to Know Terms of Any Existing Contracts

What if I'm Moving out of The Community?

- May Opt-Out Free If Moving Out of the Community
- May Leave Any Other Time Without a Termination Fee

How Do We Strike the Program's Natural Gas Price?

- Can Strike within Specified Time Before Contract Start
- Strike Price For Full or Portion of Contract Term
- Secure Retail Adder to Mitigate Risk
- It can be based off the Local Utility Rate
- Calculate & Track Indicative Pricing Based on NYMEX Strike During Favorable Market Conditions by Having Authorized Official Sign and Fax Strike Notice
