

**REGULAR MEETING**

Don will contact Ed Jakubick to look at the restroom refurbishing. Swings are ordered. Discussed possibilities for cameras, alarms, and locking of restrooms – fortunately there have been no recent problems.

**Pearl Park** – The bid opening for the restroom project will be June 19<sup>th</sup>. Shane did talk to LAC and they do plan on painting the dugouts – will recommend a tan color or a stain similar to the kiosk.

**Eastlake Park** – The city still needs a bulldozer. We need to get dirt moved and plant some seasonal grass so that sledding will be available this winter. We can then repeat the process next year.

**Shane Mealy** made a motion to adjourn, seconded by **Katie Watson**. **ALL AYES, MOTION APPROVED.**

After adjournment of the regular meeting, the board went to Pearl Park for the annual walk-through.

- Paint fence and backstop at ballfield.
