Pearl Park

Lakeview's fall tennis season has begun – the coach has key to dedicated restroom and off to a good start. Need to look at refurbishing or replacing bleachers @ softball field. Mayor stated that due to funding new doors for restrooms will be put off until next year.

Eastlake Park

City has been working to build up hill. Need some clean fill and/or top soil. City will set up meeting with Zach (Metroparks) to see if we can get the sledding hill open this year.

Other Issues

Rotary will extract letters from current sign at Rotary Park and build new smaller sign with left over pavers and split face block. City will tear down existing sign after letters are removed.
