

PARKS & RECREATION BOARD

September 12, 2016

The Parks & Recreation Board met on Monday, September 12, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. at the City Administration Building, 400 N. High St., Cortland, Ohio. In attendance were the following board members: Dave Christner, Katie Watson, Patty Collier, and Cara DeToro. Also present were Mayor Jim Woofter, Service Director Don Wittman and the following individuals: Jerry Carleton and Dave Majick.

Katie Watson made a motion to approve minutes from the August 8, 2016 meeting, seconded by **Patty Collier**. **ALL AYES, MOTION APPROVED.**

Jerry Carleton & Dave Majick – Issues with pickleball surface. CAPA has tried to do spot filling. 18 mos. ago had estimate for approx. \$35,000 for repaving and another \$6-7,000 for surface. They have visited other facilities to see what they do and looked at other alternatives. Ohio Concrete recommends a concrete overlay – They obtained an estimate of \$25,000 for material and to put in concrete from King Bros. This was then taken to Mercy Health's foundation and they have agreed to provide grant for ½ of this cost. This is a match requiring a commitment for the other half from the city. They are interested in this as promoting a health oriented activity.

The Board and the Mayor commended them for their efforts in investigating alternatives and finding funding to assist in this project.

Dave Christner stated we know we need to do something with both pickleball and tennis courts but how do we get over hurdle of money that is needed? Which is best solution: concrete or blacktop? We would like to work on this between now and December 1. All agreed.

Willow Park –

- Need comprehensive poison ivy deterrent plan.

Pearl Park –

- Splash Pad is closed for year.
- City has contacted John Foraker regarding leak repair and maintenance.
- Katie will email recognition plaque layout for final approval.
- Have received donations for 4 benches – will be ordering black.
- GC Construction will construct pavilion and will coordinate with Integra – should be done in next few weeks.
- Don still hasn't received information from OE regarding the pole.

Eastlake Park –

Miller Yount had someone doing bulldozer work Saturday and today. Hill looks great. Plan on having joint meeting with TCMP in October.

Katie Watson made a motion to adjourn, seconded by **Cara DeToro**. **ALL AYES, MOTION APPROVED.**
