

PARKS & RECREATION BOARD

January 9, 2017

The Parks & Recreation Board met on Monday, January 9, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. at the City Administration Building, 400 N. High St., Cortland, Ohio. In attendance were the following board members: Dave Christner, Patty Coller, Cara DeToro and Joe Goske. Also present were Mayor Jim Woofter and Service Director Don Wittman.

Cara DeToro made a motion to approve minutes from the November 14, 2016 regular meeting, seconded by Patty Coller. **ALL AYES, MOTION APPROVED.**

Budget – Members need to bring ideas to next month’s meeting. A top priority is pickleball resurfacing – Donations will cover most/all of the asphalt cost – Question on timing to seal like other services – if a year may not have that cost until 2018.

Joe Goske made a motion to accept service agreement with My Splash Pad for annual maintenance, start-up and shut-down of the splash pad at a cost of \$950.00, seconded by Cara Detoro. **ALL AYES, MOTION PASSED.**

Willow Park – Mayor asked that board consider adding Dog Waste Bag Stations at Willow Park and Pearl Park.

Pearl Park – Ohio Edison has installed the light pole. Mayor had report from neighboring resident regarding roof on pavilion. Installation on pavilion is supposed to resume next week

Eastlake Park – Off to a great start – came out very well. Would like to consider 1 or 2 nights and rent lights and offer this to the community. This may not happen until next year. Would like to add a fire pit.

Other Issues –

Masonic Lodge would like to install a Veteran’s Memorial in the City. One location being considered is City Hall. They would like this to be a community event with them being the lead organization but with cooperation of other service organizations. Plans would have to first be brought to Parks Board if on City property.

TCTC is working on cost of materials for the picnic tables for Pearl Park pavilion.

Patty Coller made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Cara DeToro. **ALL AYES, MOTION APPROVED.**
