Willow Park –

- Pickleball resurfacing – Arrow Surface Engineering had the low quote. Council will see 3rd reading on July 3rd so on track for mid-July or so.
- Reported that “roller bladers” were playing street hockey on pickleball court and took down some nets and there were some issues between the various parties. Discussion followed but no action taken.
- Missing basketball hoop was replaced.
- Request was sent to Service Department during the month for swings wrapped around upper support.

Pearl Park –

- Installed two baby swings.
- Landscaping by Gilmore will be done in the fall
- Reported concerns from splinters from picnic tables/benches
- Splash Pad Committee plans to meet and disband and close out account with the Foundation sending remaining balance to city for incurred expenses.
- Discussed signs for hours and rules
- Dave has wire – need to trench for camera
- Discussed rocky area adjacent to pavilion

Eastlake Park –

- Would like to add large rocks to prevent people from driving on hill and runout area (like the ones at Willow)
- Need to move fire pit
- Have ordered the “Sun Up to Sun Down” sign
- Will probably hydro-seed again in the fall
- Will need to do some re-sloping

Other Issues –

- Requested Event at Pearl Park – (Citizen did not come to the meeting as requested) Event would be allowed if open to everyone. Bounce house would not be allowed due to liability.
