

PARKS & RECREATION BOARD

August 14, 2017

The Parks & Recreation Board met on Monday, August 14, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. at the City Administration Building, 400 N. High St., Cortland, Ohio. In attendance were the following board members: Dave Christner, Patty Coller, Cara DeToro and Sonya Picuri. Also present were Mayor Jim Woofter, Service Director Don Wittman, Councilman Scott Rowley and Dave Majick.

Mayor Woofter swore in Sonya Picuri to fill the vacant position with term expiring 12/31/2020.

Cara DeToro made a motion to approve minutes from the July 10, 2017 regular meeting, seconded by Dave Christner. ALL AYES, MOTION APPROVED.

Dave Christner nominated Patty Coller to fill the position of Vice Chairman, seconded by Cara Detoro. ALL AYES, MOTION APPROVED.

Willow Park –

- Pickleball resurfacing:
 - Scheduled to begin 8/23 weather permitting. Courts will be closed starting 8/21 so prep work can be done. Hopefully asphalt will be down end of next week. Courts will be closed approx. 1 ½ weeks.
 - City will then stripe with temporary striping.
 - Courts need to cure for at least 30 days (preferably longer) so plan is get quotes for the color coating early 2018.
 - Dave Majick had the following comments or suggestions: hopes benches will remain or be replaced, would like to color coordinate with Lakeview, suggested sand in white striping (balls skip on white).
- Continued concern on profanity and issues at basketball court. Other communities have closed their courts. Will ask police for increased presence.
- Lakeview tennis starts next week.
- Repair corner post on basketball court.

Pearl Park –

- Splash Pad has been very busy – Good feedback on park/pavilion. Report that timer may be off.
- Would like to designate pavilion and splash pad area as “No Smoking”
- Issues that need follow-up: dirt around pavilion, contact with Gilmore on landscaping
- Damaged slide

Eastlake Park –

- Will need to fence off back side.
- Plan to rake out and hydro-seed again in the fall.
- Move fire pit and barricade rocks from Willow.

Other Issues –

Reservation Policy – Would like to formalize policy for organizations that help maintain the facilities.
